McCarty said figuring the loads and skews and slopes of the hangers presented quite a challenge for ABC's technicians, who worked closely with their hanger supplier's engineering department. 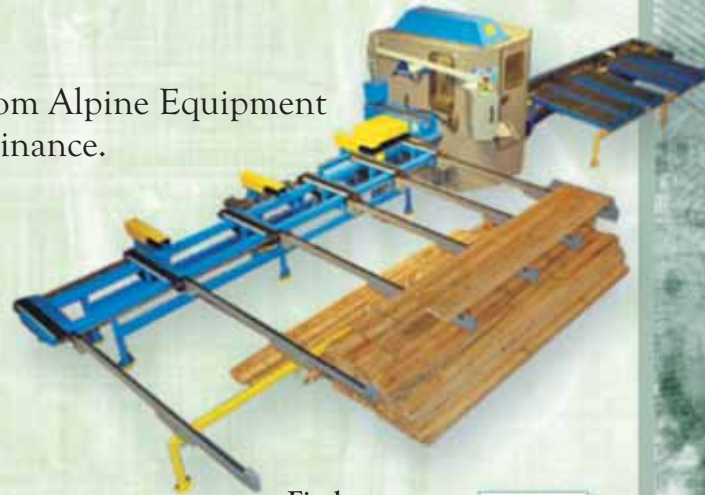
