We recently had one of our members call about an OSHA inspection that resulted in a \$2,000 fine for cuts and abrasions that had occurred at its truss plant. The issue that was brought up was - "are there any good gloves that work in a truss plant or ways to reduce cuts that really work?"

We put this company in touch with several companies that we felt could help. The

outcome was that the truss plant now re-quires the employee to do one of three things.

- 1. Wear a Nitrile Coated Glove from Perfect Fit Glove Co.
- 2. Wrap their fingers in Athletic Tape
- 3. Wrap their fingers in breathable Saf-T-Tape
